2.15 Future of the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service

Ricky Dibble, Station Manager in Dingwall will give a presentation about the changes that are happening within the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service. The 1947 Act of Parliament established fire services in their current form and provided the foundations for a service that has ensured communities are safer than they have ever been from the risk of fire. However with fires reducing and new risks such as terrorism and flooding emerging, the SFRS needs to change too. This is a great opportunity to find out more and to influence how the changes will be implemented locally.
